




Local anesthesia

Complete analgesia Anesthetic sparing Inexpensive Not controlled drugs

DRUG	ONSET TIME (mins)	DOSE* mg/kg	"TOXIC" DOSE mg/kg
Lidocaine	1-2 (<5)	2-6	Dog 11-20 Cat 6-10
Bupivacaine	2-10 (20)	1-2	Dog 5-11 Cat 3
Mepivacaine	2-5 (10)	2-5	Dog 29 Cat ?

CONCLUSIONS AND RELEVANCE:

Targeted bupivacaine reduced early postoperative pain scores following routine feline ovariohysterectomies.

The technique used was simple, requiring just over a minute to perform at minimal additional cost.

Transverse fractures of the dorsal aspects of the right eighth through twelfth ribs.

Fragments of the eighth and ninth ribs are protruding into the pleural space.

Chronic healed right sixth and seventh rib fractures.






Retrobulbar block


